## WHO CAN JOIN THE BSA?

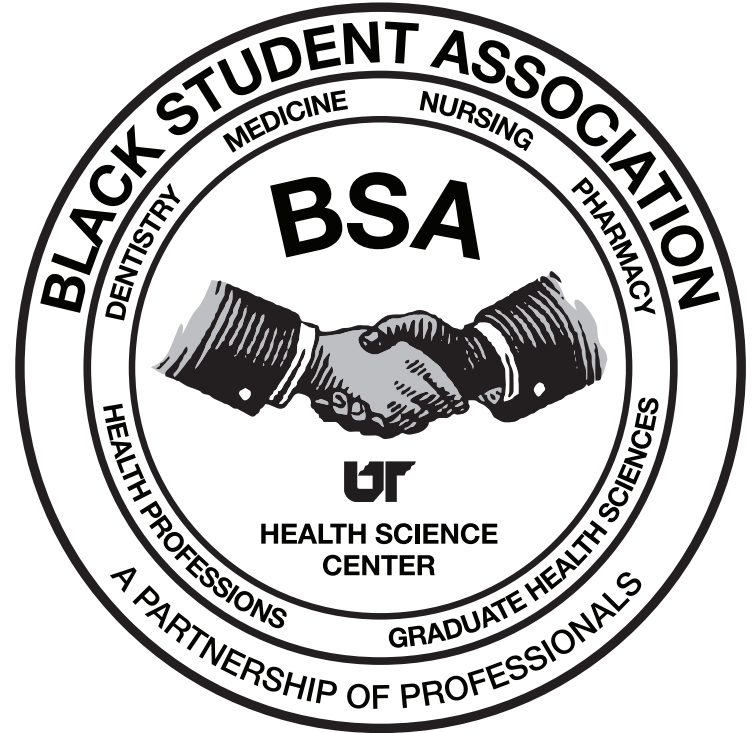
